The DIY Dish

"Basic Bag"



Materials Needed:
1 yard of Fabric #1
1 yard of Fabric #2
Sewing Machine
Straight Pins
Rotary Cutter/Mat
Ruler



****Note:** You will make 2 bags -- one becomes the outside of the bag, while the other becomes the lining of your bag. Be sure to complete the steps outlined in the video, two times.

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Tips for Making The DIY Dish Basic Bag

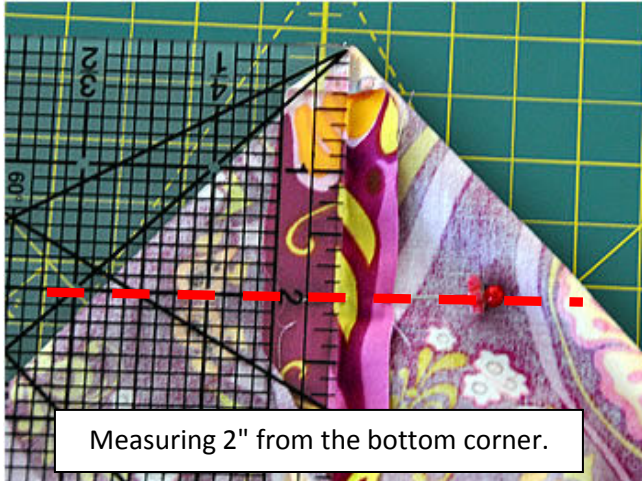

It's important to cut the fabric as shown in the photos below. By doing this, you'll have enough fabric for both the **outside** and **lining** of your bag.

From each fabric, cut the following: (2) 14x30" strips
(1) 7x28" strip



Below are some up-close photos from segments in the video.

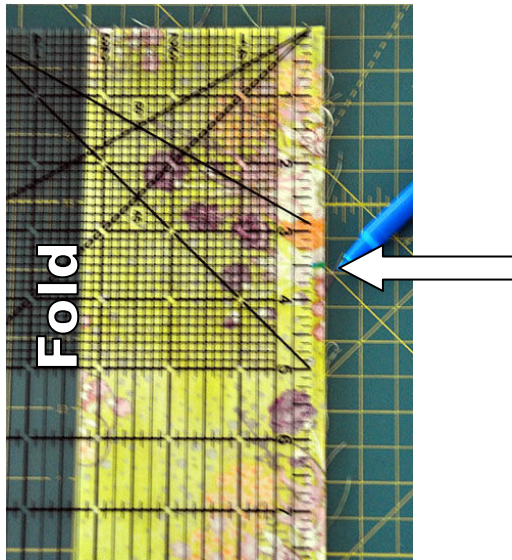


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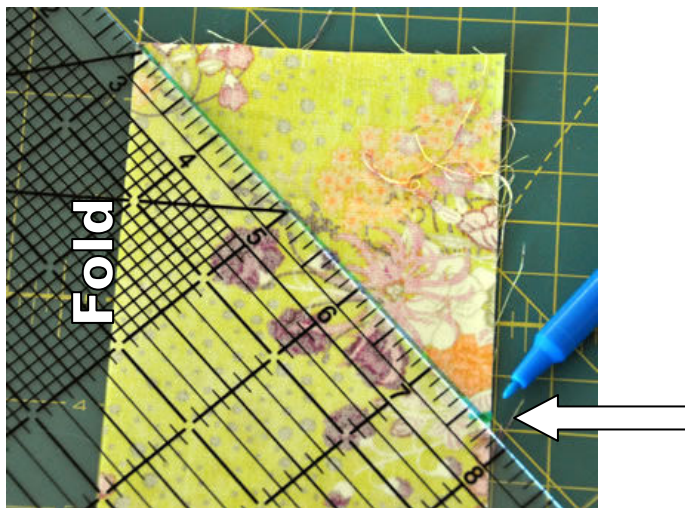


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Here are the steps we did to complete each end of the bag's handle.



1. Measure down 3.5" down from each end of handle. Mark with a fabric pen.



2. Place a ruler at an angle, beginning at the top left corner and going down to the 3.5" mark that you did in step #1. Draw a line along this angle.



3. Cut along marked line and sew according to instructions in video.
